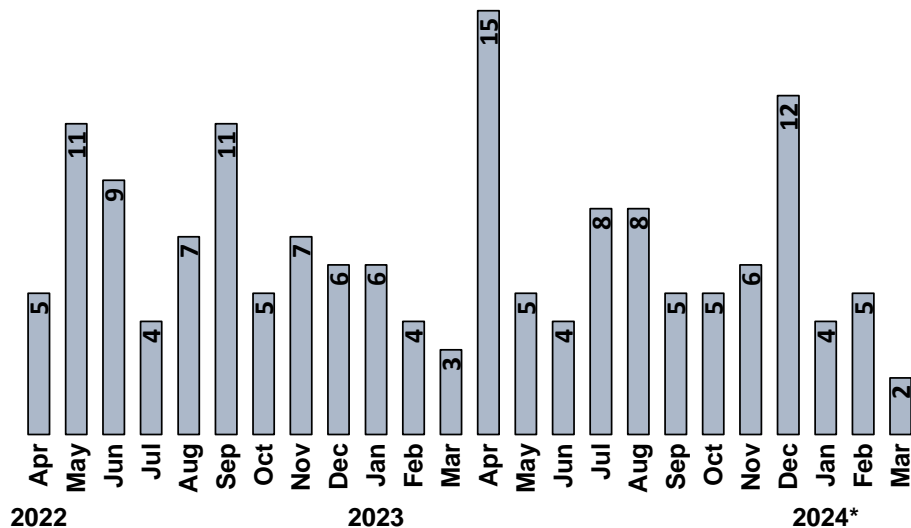

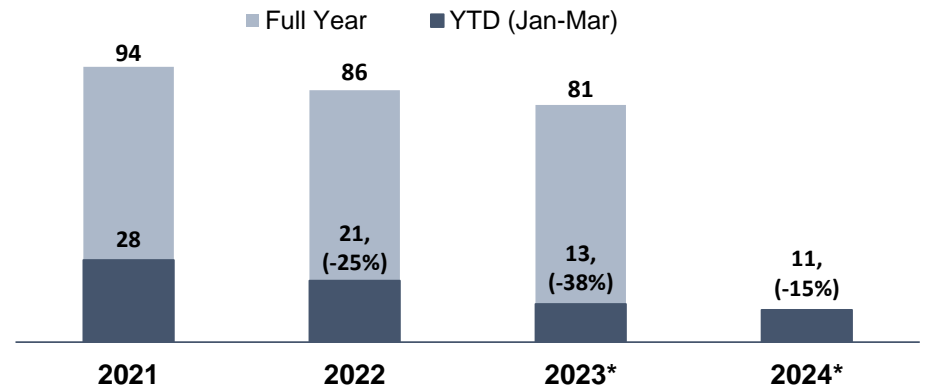
Last 24 Months of Fentanyl-Positive Deaths in Robeson County



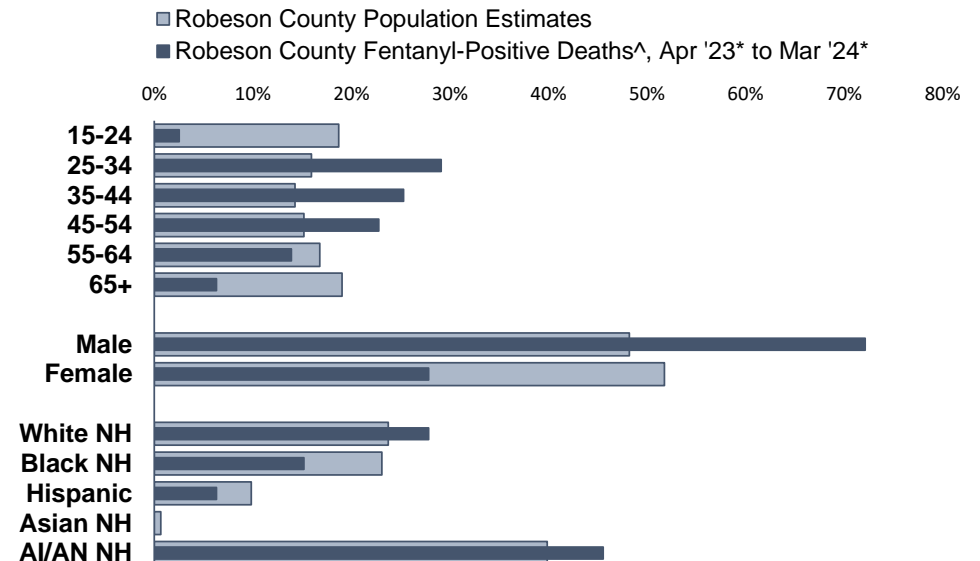

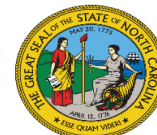
Fentanyl-Positive Deaths: 2021-2024* YTD in Robeson County
